### **1. INDIAN KNOWLEDGE SYSTEMS (IKS)**

#### **Objectives of the Practice**

The main objectives of promoting Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) are as follows:

- To integrate traditional Indian wisdom with modern education and research.
- To create awareness among students about the rich heritage and diverse knowledge systems of India.
- To provide interdisciplinary learning opportunities by combining ancient knowledge with contemporary science and technology.
- To familiarize students with various ancient Indian systems like Ayurveda, Yoga, Vedanta and Indian mathematics.
- To cultivate a sense of pride and responsibility among students towards preserving and propagating Indian knowledge traditions in keeping with NEP-2020.

#### **The Context**

The introduction of Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) on our campus is fostering a deeper understanding of India's vast intellectual heritage. By integrating IKS with academic curricula, the institution aims to:

- Promote a holistic approach to learning by blending traditional and modern knowledge.
- Encourage students in areas such as Indian philosophical thought and ancient scientific principles.
- Organize workshops, lectures, and seminars by experts in various disciplines of IKS.
- Provide interdisciplinary platforms to study ancient texts and practices in fields like linguistics, astronomy, architecture and performing arts.
- Address contemporary challenges using sustainable practices derived from IKS.

#### **The Practice**

Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) offer an inclusive and innovative framework for education, research and societal development. The institution has constructed a Centre for IKS and implemented following initiatives to promote IKS:

- Identification of the modules and courses on the topics related to Indian Knowledge Systems.
- Collaborations with institutions and scholars specializing in ancient Indian knowledge domains.
- Introductory workshops on Indian Knowledge Systems.
- Practical sessions on Yoga, emphasizing holistic health and wellness.
- Regular events on IKS to showcase the diversity and relevance of IKS in modern times.
- Offering add-on course based on IKS.

### **Evidence of Success**

Over the past two years, the integration of IKS has significantly enriched the academic and cultural environment of the institution:

- Increased student participation in courses and workshops on Indian Knowledge Systems.
- Enhanced research output with project and papers focusing on the application of IKS in contemporary contexts.
- Greater awareness among students and faculty about the importance of preserving and propagating Indian heritage.
- Successful collaborations with national and international organizations to promote interdisciplinary research in IKS.
- Successful conduction of a 4 Day discipline specific training program in *Arthashastra* and *Nitishastra* in collaboration with UGC and IKS division of Ministry of Education, New Delhi. In this event 33 participants across 32 universities of India participated. They were conferred the title of "Master Trainers" by UGC.

### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

Initially, the implementation of Indian Knowledge Systems faced several challenges:

- Need for additional resources, such as translation tools, research grants, and infrastructure for hands-on learning (e.g., *Ayurveda* labs and *Yoga* centers).

Though some challenges are yet not resolved but the institution is taking important steps in order to resolve them. To address these challenges, the institution:

- Organized discipline-specific programs to familiarize stakeholders with IKS content relevant to their respective fields.
- Conducted awareness programs in the form of Workshops to highlight the contemporary relevance of IKS.

With sustained efforts, the institution aims to further strengthen the integration of IKS into mainstream education, thereby nurturing a generation that values and applies traditional wisdom in modern contexts.

## **2. INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (ICT)**

### **Objectives of the Practice**

The main objectives of introducing ICT are as follow:

- To create, manage, store, and disseminate information and knowledge.
- To train the stake holders of teaching-learning process (teaching, non teaching staffs and students) on the use of different online modes to assess, work, store and communicate necessary information.
- To familiarize students with different online platforms.
- To motivate the students to register in portals like AI ChatGpt INFLIBNET
- To digitalize teaching-learning process, library, administrative jobs (Admission, Finance, Hostel allotment and procuring various goods).

### **The Context**

ICT helps the stakeholders of the college in

- Conducting online classes, assignments, tests, webinars, web workshops, online presentations, Quiz, Brainstorming sessions,
- Collaborating with various Institutions,
- Mentoring,
- Guidance and counselling,
- Awareness programmes,
- Providing Individualized instruction,
- Managing group projects.
- Formative and Diagnostic evaluation
- Admissions
- Fee collection
- Executing Administrative works.

### **The Practice**

Information and Communications Technology (ICT) is indeed beneficial for the growth and development of young minds as well as institution in totality. There is a constant emphasis laid on the usage of ICT and as the times are moving ahead, problems of network and connectivity issues too are gradually warding off, giving space to a number of students for learning and equipping themselves with the changing times and its norms. All the teachers are using Synchronous

Learning Management System like Google Classroom and different Asynchronous LMS like Mentimeter, Escape room, Breakup room, Exit Ticket, Techmint etc. Teachers are using various Quiz makers like Kahoot, Quizzory, Google Forms and Surveyheart to make their teaching learning more effective.

### **Different departments use Apps for advanced learning:**

- Psychology-E-Prime and Grey Scale software for planning and presentation experiment
- Geography-Q-GIS and Arc-GIS for Mapping purpose
- AIHC & Archaeology- Google Earth, Google Map and Al pinequest for Mapping of historical sites
- French-Duolingo, Word reference, Dictionnaire Francais Livio, Thierry Perrot and Macromedia Flashplayers Apps for learning the foreign language
- Sanskrit- Ashtadhyayi App for learning Sanskrit grammar in an effective way
- The college library is fully automated and uses SLIM21 (3.6.0) software.
- All the books in the library are bar-coded
- The Language Lab of the college has installed i-Lotus Linguaphone.
- Knowledge Center facilitates digital learning.
- The Administrative block is also updated with Tally, Turning Point-Eduware and Compu Office for administrative activities and to facilitate the stakeholders.
- Wi-Fi campus.
- Expansion of computer lab with 110 desktops

### **Evidence of Success**

In the last three years, there has been a constant improvement in usage of ICT tools and more and more new practices are being employed under its umbrella for making the teaching learning process easier and accessible for all. The office of the institution is also constantly getting more and more equipped with various tools of ICT which can ease the process relating to money transfers, transactions, fee payment, hostel allotment etc. Besides, the college management provided support in procuring necessary tools like computers and projectors.

### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

Initially usage of ICT was a bit challenging as many students who were in remote areas of the country were unable to access the resources because of network issues. The teachers also may record the lectures for students which they could later attend as per the availability of network at their ends. The number of computers and smart classes with projectors are required to be increased in future as keeping the high demand in time.



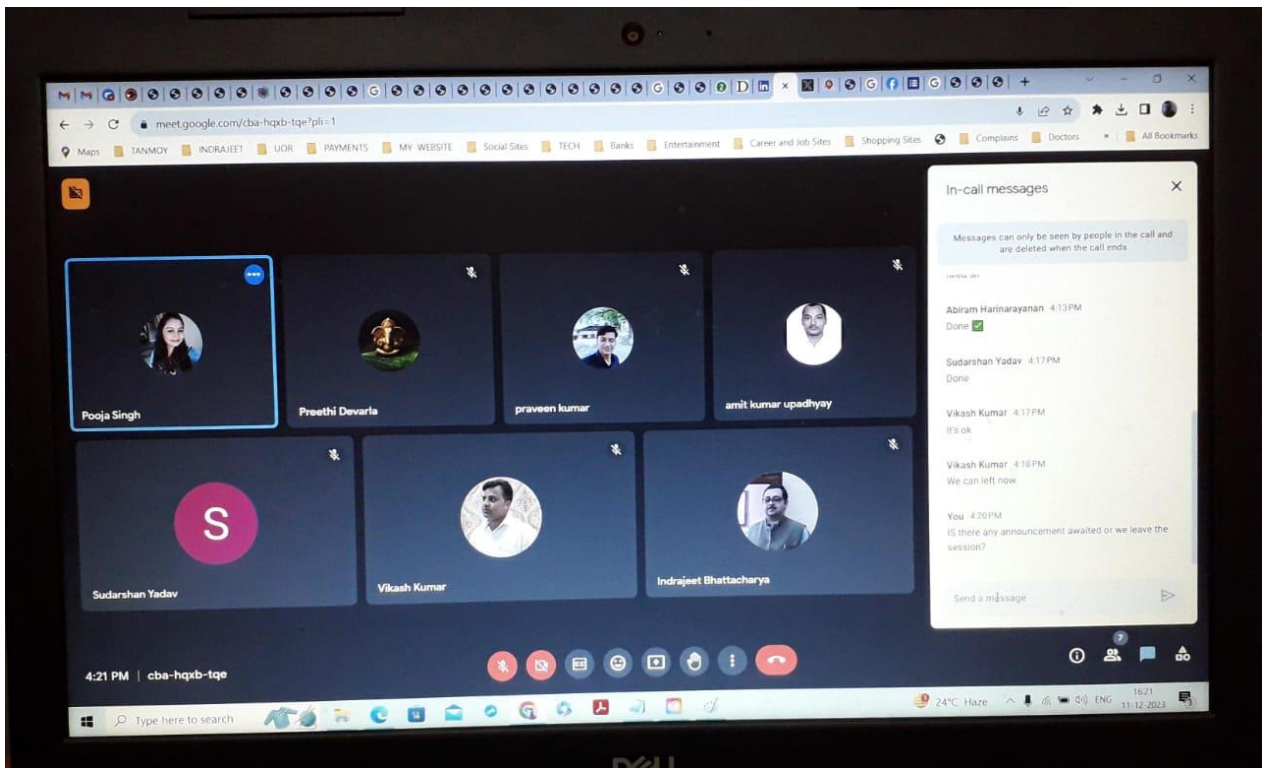

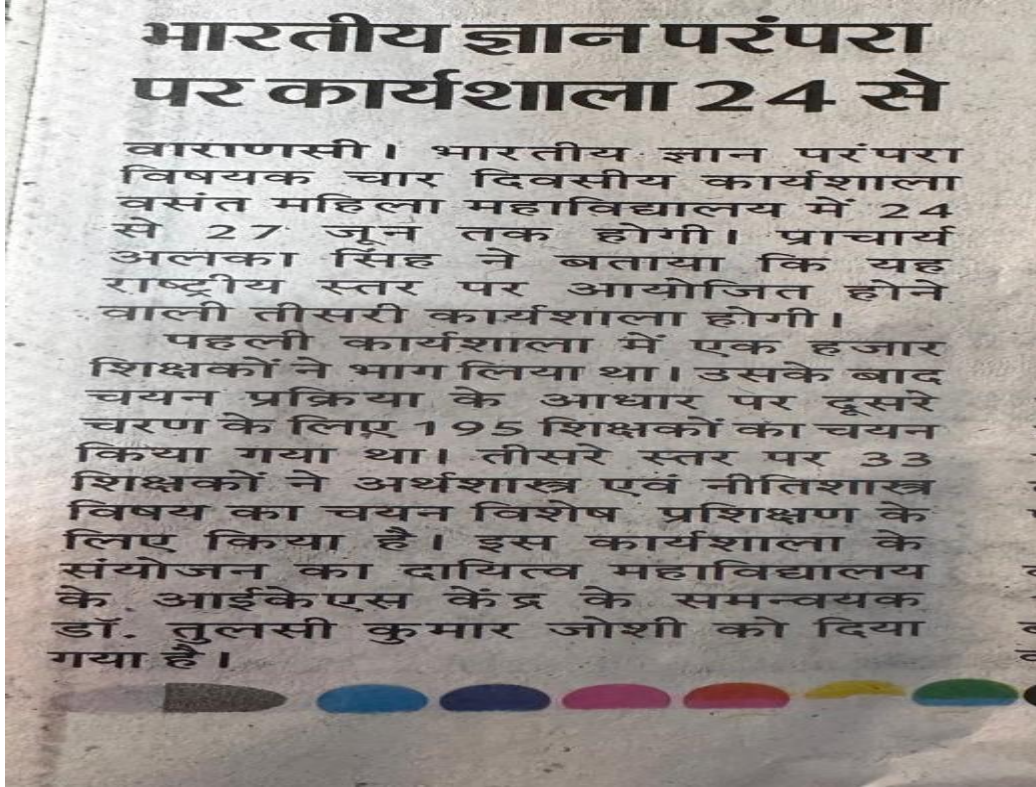

#### ADD-ON COURSE ON INTRODUCTION TO INDIAN KNOWLEDGE SYSTEMS

#### **Introduction:**

Indian Knowledge Systems refer to an epitome of knowledge repository originated and preserved in India since the time immemorial.
